

Power System Services are not registered for handling, properly trained or Insured to work in or with materials containing asbestos.

Should anybody find any suspect materials during the course of their works they should report this to their supervisor immediately who will in turn report its occurrence to the site owners. The Owner/ Client should then employ registered testing and removal firms to eliminate the risk of exposure. Until such time that the material is confirmed not to contain asbestos or has been removed under controlled conditions, do not work adjacent to or in a confined area containing the substance.

If somebody is directly exposed to suspect materials during the course of their works they should;

- Report this to their supervisor who will in turn report its occurrence to the site owners.
- They should stay in the vicinity of the incident but not directly adjacent to the material and away from others.
- The client will deploy properly trained personnel to come to the location of the affected person and remove clothing that could have been contaminated for destroying.
- Once the clients specialist is satisfied that the operative has removed relevant items the affected person will be escorted to showering facilities where he can wash off completely.
- Replacement clothing shall be supplied as required.
- Do not remove Repertory PPE until over garments are removed and washing is commencing.

If in doubt ask. Exposure to Asbestos is extremely serious. Protect yourself and your work colleagues by following this guidance.
