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## Health and Safety Policy Statement

Managers must be conversant with the contents of this policy and must plan, regularly review and develop this policy. All employees are required to comply with this policy and must understand their specific responsibilities, which are outlined in the organisation responsibilities section. This includes co-operating with the Company on safety matters and taking care of their own health and safety and the safety of others affected by their activities. Every employee has the right to raise health and safety concerns with a Manager. Effective two way communication and consultation of health and safety is essential and will be achieved by health and safety being a set agenda item at meetings and during employee consultations.

The policy will be brought to the attention of all employees though induction training and a copy will be displayed on the health and safety notice board at our site(s). Furthermore each employee will be provided with a copy of the policy. This policy will be reviewed annually or more frequently as necessary in the light of legislation requirements or significant changes to the way we operate our business.
